We need your help to recruit members

We must recruit more members. We are still well short of the 500 we need for federal electoral registration. Federal registration is extremely important. This allows us to have the name of our party printed next to our candidate names on the ballot paper.

It is interesting that, although persons I speak to are invariably enthusiastic and supportive of our aims, it is very hard to get them to actually join up.

As previously advised we have produced a flyer (attached to the last Newsletter, which is shown on our website) that we have been letterboxing. We have distributed approx 5000 of these to date, and they have been quite successful. We very much need help in distributing more of these. I find I am able to letterbox 500 in a day without too much trouble (in suburbs with average housing density).

If you cannot help personally, we would accept donations that we can use to employ a conscientious lady we know (and who needs the money at present) to do this.
